


## Tachinidae (Diptera) from the Monegros

Among the Diptera, the Tachinidae are the largest family of flies. Its members are all parasitoids of arthropods (nearly all of them insects). They are of special importance as a natural limiting factor of insect pests. More than 400 species are known from the Iberian Peninsula (Tschorsnig, 1992).

Up to now, 82 species of tachinids have been collected from the Monegros (cf. Tschorsnig, Andersen & Blasco-Zumeta 1997). These are certainly not all. For a number of them the Monegros is at present the only known locality for the Iberian Peninsula. Because of its high ecological value with many rare species of Tachinidae, special protection is needed for the Monegros region.
